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Bible Reading Plan

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Why read the whole Bible?

The words of the Bible do many things – teach us, challenge our thinking, feed our souls... God can use any form of reading to do any of these, but some lend themselves better to one purpose over another.

Reading the entire Bible over a defined period, such as one year or three years, allows us to take in the whole story. By revealing God in all his glory, this form of Bible reading leaves us humbled, enthralled, transformed.

In Deuteronomy 17:19-20, God taught the king what to do with the Bible.

It is to be with him, and he is to read it all the days of his life...

The king was to read the Bible all the days of his life. This is a lifestyle of constant input.

...so that...

God was expecting three key outcomes from this reading.

...he may learn to revere the Lord his God...

When we read through the breadth of God's dealings with his people, we are exposed to the depth of God's love.

...and follow carefully all the words of this law and these decrees...

When we read all the words of the Bible we are exposed to many different authors, accounts and genres. Each presents a different perspective on who God is and what it means to follow him. Reading the breadth of the Bible leads us away from the places of familiarity and confronts us with a bigger God than we would expect.

How to read the whole Bible

...and **not consider himself better** than his fellow Israelites and turn from the law to the right or to the left.

A danger of focused study is conceit and self-righteousness. A broad reading of the Scriptures challenges our interpretations with inconvenient facts. These demonstrate a greater mystery than we had imagined. In this knowledge, we walk with God in humility.

Then he and his descendants will reign a long time over his kingdom in Israel.

There is an eternal blessing for those who follow this advice.

This is intended to be an encounter with God rather than some trial of strength. To that end, it is good to start with prayer and be relaxed about progress.

This plan aims to give you a consistent amount to read each day. This helps you find a regular slot each day to read in. I read before going to bed, others first thing in the morning, yet others during a meal break. Find what suits your schedule and temperament.

Inevitably there will be days missed. The reason there are numbers rather than dates is to enable you to just shrug it off and press on without the sense that you are falling behind. Accept that the day is missed and at the next opportunity carry on the sequence.

When you reach the end, go back to the beginning and start again. The aim of the plan is not to achieve having read the Bible, but to help you maintain a lifestyle of reading it.

One tip to leave you with. I use sticky index flags to mark the various places where I am reading – it makes finding the passage that bit easier.

How the plan works

Designed to be dynamic, this plan offers a choice of time frames and provides context by arranging different types of literature alongside their historical counterparts.

One, Two or Three Years

There are three columns, each with 365 passages. Two columns are readings from the Old Testament and one column from the New Testament. If you combine a New Testament reading every day with either one or two Old Testament readings, this will take you through the Bible in one or two years. If you read one column per year you will spread the whole Bible over three years.

Consistent Reading Length

Within each column, the reading lengths of the passages are approximately consistent. The New Testament readings are generally shorter than the Old Testament ones. However, some passages may deviate in length where the text could not be split without losing the sense of what is being read.

Column 1: Old Testament

Pentateuch and Wisdom

Column 1 consists of the first books of the Bible from the beginning through to before the government of Israel was formalised. Interspersed are the wisdom books – the poetic literature addressing heart issues, from suffering in Job through to pleasure in Ecclesiastes.

Some of the readings in Exodus and Leviticus contain a lot of detail about the construction of the worship place, called the Tabernacle. These are interspersed with the words of worship written in the Psalms.

Some psalms appear in column 2, where they are linked to their historical context.

Column 2: Old Testament

Historical books of the kings and exile, along with prophetic writings

Column 2 takes us through the history from Samuel, the last of the judges, through to the return from exile. In many cases, psalms that we know were written at a certain point in the history are inserted just after the event. Likewise, prophetic books are inserted into the timeline approximately when their author was known to have lived.

Where there are long genealogical lists, these are broken up with psalms.

Column 3: New Testament

Gospels, epistles and Revelation

The four accounts of Jesus are spaced out through the year. Each one is followed by books that are related to that Gospel or its style. For example, the letters of Peter follow Mark, which is believed to have been written by a companion of Peter.

Luke was one of Paul's travelling companions, so his Gospel is followed by letters to others that they travelled with. This is followed by Acts, Luke's story of the early church. When Paul has written a letter to a church in a city, that letter is inserted following Paul's visit to the city.

The plan

Read the Bible in one year by reading the passages in all three columns each day. Read the Bible in two years by reading the passages from Column 1 and Column 3 in the first year, and from Column 2 and Column 3 again in the second year. Read the Bible in three years by reading one column of passages each year.
