They discussed this with one another and said, "It is because we have no bread."

Mark 12:7 TNIV Chapter

"But the tenants said to one another, 'This is the heir. Come, let's kill him, and the inheritance will be ours.'

Mark 14:4 TNIV Chapter

Some of those present were saying indignantly to one another, "Why this waste of perfume?"

Luke 2:15 TNIV Chapter

When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.

John 13:35 TNIV Chapter

By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

John 16:17 TNIV Chapter

Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. [ Or willing to do menial work] Do not think you are superior.

Romans 13:8 TNIV Chapter

[ Love Fulfills the Law ] Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law.

Romans 14:13 TNIV Chapter

Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister.

Romans 15:7 TNIV Chapter

Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.

Romans 15:14 TNIV Chapter

[ Paul the Minister to the Gentiles ] I myself am convinced, my brothers and sisters, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with knowledge and competent to instruct one another.

Romans 16:16 TNIV Chapter

Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ send greetings.

1 Corinthians 1:10 TNIV Chapter

[ A Church Divided Over Leaders ] I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.

1 Corinthians 16:20 TNIV Chapter

All the brothers and sisters here send you greetings. Greet one another with a holy kiss.

2 Corinthians 13:11 TNIV Chapter

[ Final Greetings ] Finally, brothers and sisters, rejoice! Strive for full restoration, encourage one another, be of one mind, live in peace. And the God of love and peace will be with you.

2 Corinthians 13:12 TNIV Chapter

Greet one another with a holy kiss.

Galatians 5:13 TNIV Chapter

[ Life by the Spirit ] You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature [ Or the flesh; also in verses 16, 17, 19 and 24 ] ; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

Ephesians 4:2 TNIV Chapter

Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

Ephesians 4:32 TNIV Chapter

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Ephesians 5:19 TNIV Chapter

speaking to one another with psalms, hymns and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord,

Ephesians 5:21 TNIV Chapter

[ Instructions for Christian Households ] Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

Philippians 2:5 TNIV Chapter

In your relationships with one another, have the same attitude of mind Christ Jesus had:

Colossians 3:13 TNIV Chapter

Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Colossians 3:16 TNIV Chapter

Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

1 Thessalonians 4:9 TNIV Chapter

Now about your love for one another we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other.

1 Thessalonians 4:18 TNIV Chapter

Therefore encourage one another with these words.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 TNIV Chapter

Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

2 Thessalonians 1:3 TNIV Chapter

[ Thanksgiving and Prayer ] We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing.

Titus 3:3 TNIV Chapter

At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another.

Hebrews 3:13 TNIV Chapter

But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.

Hebrews 8:11 TNIV Chapter

No longer will they teach their neighbors, or say to one another, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest.

Hebrews 10:24 TNIV Chapter

And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds,

not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrews 13:1 TNIV Chapter

[ Concluding Exhortations ] Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters.

James 4:11 TNIV Chapter

Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it.

James 5:9 TNIV Chapter

Don't grumble against one another, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door!

1 Peter 1:22 TNIV Chapter

Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart. [ Some early manuscripts from a pure heart ]

1 Peter 3:8 TNIV Chapter

[ Suffering for Doing Good ] Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble.

1 Peter 4:9 TNIV Chapter

Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.

1 Peter 5:5 TNIV Chapter

In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble and oppressed." [ Prov. 3:34 ]

1 Peter 5:14 TNIV Chapter

Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.

1 John 1:7 TNIV Chapter

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all [ Or every] sin.

1 John 3:11 TNIV Chapter

[ More on Love and Hatred ] For this is the message you heard from the beginning: We should love one another.

1 John 3:16 TNIV Chapter

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for one another.

1 John 3:23 TNIV Chapter
