PERMISSIONS GUIDELINES FOR BOOKS AND ON-LINE RESOURCES

For non-commercial (not to be sold) use

- Navigators UK grants churches and other not-for-profit organizations permission to use material from publications published by Navigators UK in church bulletins, newsletters and other short-term non-book publications free of charge, within the following limits:
 - You may quote up to 800 words from any single title, in up to three quotes, with each quote being no more than 300 words.*
 - The paragraphs quoted must not amount to a complete chapter of the book being quoted.
 - The quoted material must not comprise more than 20% of your total work.
- When a book is used in a group of not more than 20 people, you may photocopy up to 5 pages free of charge, for the first three weeks, to give you time to order copies for everyone.
- When a *free* on-line resource is downloaded, it can be used in groups of any number. You may photocopy or print as many copies of the entire publication as you need, but these copies must not be sold.

For commercial (to be sold) use

- You may quote up to 50 words in a product to be sold, so long as this does not comprise more than 5% of the product.*
- Quotes used in cards, calendars or artistic work must not comprise more than 5% of the completed work, or permission is required.
- Permission is required to use any photos or illustrations.*
- Permission is required to translate into another language.

If you do require permission, please contact publications@navigators.co.uk. You may be required to pay a fee, at the discretion of Navigators UK. If the author holds the copyright, Navigators UK will contact the author for you.
